SA Breeders Willow Grove Stud, Mill Park Stud and Cornerstone Stud achieved good results at the recent Inglis Melbourne Premier Yearling Sale.

- Willow Grove sold all 7 yearlings grossing \$433,000 averaging \$61,800, with their top priced Zousain colt going to Danny Beasley Racing for \$100,000.
- Mill Park sold 3 with a top price of \$150,000 for the Blue Point (IRE) x Affair to Remember bred by David Peacock.
- Cornerstone finished up as the leading SA vendor grossing \$650,000, with their star lot being an Ole Kirk Filly selling for \$200,000 to Lindsay Park Racing / Dean Hawthorne Bloodstock (BAFNZ), VIC.
- Terry Hodgson sold a Hellbent filly for \$120,000 through the Widden Stud draft selling to Pulse Racing Thoroughbreds / Pinhook Bloodstock International (FBAA) / Richard & Will Freedman.

From a catalogue of 455 yearlings, SA Breeders provided 95 lots and achieved some great results.

Local breeder Julie Barnes from Whim Park led the way knocking it out of the park with her two beautifully presented Colts by Nicconi and Grunt making \$120,000 and \$85,000 respectively, both quality colts were purchased by Hong Kong buyers.

In a tough market Mill Park sold all their yearlings to be leading SA vendor averaging **\$81,500**. The top seller, a bay colt by So You Think x Miss Otto was purchased by Will Clarken Bloodstock and former Adelaide Crows Chairman Rob Chapman for \$240,000.

Historic Balcrest Stud continues their resurgence from 2024 finishing second leading SA Vendor selling 4 yearlings for an average of \$62,500.

Kate Halliday's Rosegate Park had a great sale selling 4 yearlings averaging \$51,500.

- Cornerstone Stud Lot 449 savvy buying by Sam Pritchard Gordon saw their Lucky Vega filly acquired via an online purchase for \$1,500 selling for \$100,000 to Asfoora's Royal Ascot winning trainer Henry Dwyer.

Rochelle Milnes' star continues to shine, she piloted '**I Need A Drink'** home in the Port Lincoln Cup for the second year in a row. I Need a Drink (Fiorente x Detox) was bred by Jake Stephens and is from the famous Alcopop family.

In the Adelaide Cup she guided **Silent Surrente** to a remarkable victory. The 23yo Milnes expertly maneuvered Silent Surrente from a challenging starting position to seize the lead and maintain control throughout the two-mile race.

Silent Surrente is a 6yo mare by Fiorente out of the Face Value mare, Silent Surround and was bred by the late Don Moyle and is how owned by his daughter Libby Creek.

Sir Sway further solidified his impressive record with a classy first up win in the Listed Manihi Classic 1100m. Benefiting from an ideal ride by fellow star apprentice Taylor Johnstone, Sir Sway unleashed a withering burst of speed storming home to victory.

By former SA import Sir Prancealot, Sir Sway was bred by Bruce and Jason Jaensch from Narracoorte and is trained by Sue Jaensch. Sir Sway has amassed \$366,000 in prize money to date.
