By Lindsay Park's (Angaston) Sire Estaminet (GB), second dam by Dibden Park's (Oakbank) Sire, Attalus, third dam by Balcrest Stud's (Balhannah) Sire, Coronation Boy.

A string of GR1 winners followed. Mine Gold, Gold Guru, Serious Speed, Dilly Dally, Rebel Raider and Southern Speed. He also trained the locally bred Gold Coast Magic Millions 2YO winner Augusta Proud.

Leon has already been recognised by the South Australian Thoroughbred Breeders, receiving The Matrice Award in 2011 for his outstanding results with SA Bred horses.

We wish Pam and Leon well in retirement, with the training business continuing on at Bray Street as usual, with Leon's long time training partner and son in law, Andrew Gluyas taking the reins. We wish them continued success with South Australian bred horses.
