South Australian Breeders excel in November



Foxy Frida - Inglis Bracelet

On VRC Oaks Day 6yo mare Foxy Frida by Woodside Park Stud's evergreen sire Foxwedge out of mare Family Portrait won the \$350,000 Inglis Bracelet for the second time to take her earnings to \$1.3 million.

Foxy Frida was bred by Mill Park Stud and Kellie McCarthy who are also part owners. She was offered for sale at the Inglis Melbourne Premier Sale.

On Saturday 18th November 3yo filly Brazen Style won the Group 3 \$200,000 Thoroughbred Club Stakes at Caulfield over 1200m.

Bred in the purple, Brazen Style's Sire is Darley's Brazen Beau and her dam is Group 1 winner In Style, she was purchased for \$250,000 by her trainer Shane Nichols from the Mill Park Stud draft at the 2022 Inglis Easter Yearling Sale, her breeder Michael Birchall remains in the ownership.

On the same day at Caulfield, 6yo Written Tycoon mare Rose Quartz won the Group 3 \$200,000 Neds How Now Handicap over 1200m. She was bred by partners Harry Perks and Sam Scaffidi in the Quality Thoroughbred Breeding Joint Venture.

By Written Tycoon out of Obsidian Dragon who is also the dam of Group 2 winner Seradess, that recently sold for \$700,000 in a Inglis Digital online sale.

Rose Quartz was purchased by her trainer Graeme Begg & Rohan J Hughes Bloodstock for \$300,000 from the Mill Park Draft at the 2019 Magic Millions Gold Coast January sale.

Willow Grove Stud has unearthed another rising star in 3yo filly Walk Like An Angel who raced away to win by 5 lengths in the 1200m Rebel Raider Final on Saturday 25th November at Morphettville.

By the Darley sire Impending out of Choisir mare Angel of Hope, the appropriately named Walk Like an Angel's impressive win in fast time, completed a big weekend for the Satchell Family with Tim Satchell marrying Mio Tanaka the next day.

Walk Like An Angel is trained by Andrew Gluyas and will head to the Listed Christmas Handicap at her next start.

Paul Crawford's Angas Bank farm at Strathalbyn has potentially bred Hong Kong's next wonder horse in Wunderbar. On Sunday November 26th Wunderbar smashed his rivals to make it two wins from two starts. He was brilliantly ridden by Champion Jockey James McDonald having his first ride in Hong Kong, his trainer is 11 time champion Hong Kong Trainer John Size.

Wunderbar's sire is Woodside Park Stud's emerging star Rich Enuff out of the General Nediym mare Could Be Something, he sold from the Angas Bank draft at the 2022 Adelaide Magic Million sale to the bid of Richard & Chantelle Jolly for \$140,000 on behalf of Price Bloodstock.
